How can I take part in this challenge?

1. You need to be available from 3pm – 4.30pm on your year's allocated day
2. You need to come to S14 (Miss Carnell's lab) at 3pm to register
3. You need to pay £1 to take part
4. You need to be ready to race by 3.15pm

How will the challenge work?

1. Everyone that enters in each year group will race against each other in a series of 4 v 4 races
2. You will gain points for every race you take part in:
3. 1st = 4 points; 2nd = 3 points; 3rd = 2 points; 4th = 1 point
4. The four players with the most points from each year group will compete in the **MARIO KART RAINBOW ROAD FINAL**
5. The final will be held on TUESDAY 11th July 2017 at 3pm in S14.
