Dear Parents / Carers,

Transition Week at King's Lynn Academy: 27th 28th & 29th June 2018

We are looking forward to welcoming your child to King's Lynn Academy this September.

To further prepare them for starting their secondary education we have organised a series of taster days to offer our allocated Year 6 students the opportunity to visit the Academy, meet staff and students and experience lessons and other activities.

Each day students should arrive at the Academy reception area at 9.00am. There will be a member of staff to meet them. At 2.45pm students can be collected from reception with the exception of Wednesday 27th June when you can meet your child at 3.30pm ready for the hog roast.

Parents will be expected to bring their children to the Academy unless schools make their own arrangements. Students should wear their primary school uniform. They will need to bring a pen, pencil, eraser and ruler, and a PE kit on Thursday. We would request that students do not bring mobile phones or other valuables with them.

On Thursday we will provide students with lunch in the dining room, so that they get the opportunity to experience a normal Academy lunchtime. On Wednesday and Friday they will need to bring a packed lunch with them. Those who normally receive free school meals should ask their primary school to inform us so that arrangements can be made to provide a packed lunch.

On Wednesday evening we would like to invite you and your child to attend a hog roast from 3.30pm – 5.30pm. Stratford's, our uniform supplier, will also be present.

We hope that this will be a useful and enjoyable experience for all, as we prepare for the next stage of your child's education. We are very much looking forward to welcoming our new students and families to KLA.
